****Clotheslines 2400mm or less use a 1 piece spreader bar (2 off).**

Spreader bar assembly consists of 2 Spreader Bars and 1 Joiner

① Bolt, M8 x 110mm long 2 off



② Bolt, M8 x 75mm long 4 off



③ Bolt, M8 x 60mm long 2 off



④ Lock Nut, M8 8 off



⑤ Aluminium Spacer 2 off



⑥ Nylon Spacer 2 off



⑦ Top Hat Spacer 2 Off



Layout:

- Dig 2 holes, 200mm diameter, for the posts. The hole centres are 160mm less than the length of the clothesline purchased (e.g. 2240mm for a 2400mm clothesline, or 2840mm for a 3000mm clothesline).
- The hole depth depends on the desired height of the clothesline. Ensure that the holes are deep enough that the spreader bar is level with the users head.
- Assemble the spreader bar (clotheslines larger than 2400mm) making sure that the plugged ends fare on the end (see Figure 5). Bolt onto the legs as per figure 2. Use Bolt ②, Lock Nut ④.
- Set the poles in the ground with concrete. Ensure the posts and spreader bar are level. Leave concrete to set as per manufacturer's instructions




Figure 1 – Layout.




Figure 2 – Bolt Back Bar onto Legs

Assembly:




Figure 3 – Bolt Stay Assembly onto Leg

- Bolt the Stay assembly to the OUTSIDE OF THE LEG (see Figure 3) using Bolt (2), Lock Nut (4), Nylon Spacer (6) with the "Oil" label facing the front

**** DO NOT TIGHTEN THE BOLTS ****

- Bolt the Arm to the Leg using Bolt (1), Aluminium Spacer (5) and Lock Nut (4) (see Figure 4)
- Bolt the Arm to the Stay Assembly using Bolt, (3), Top Hat Spacer (7) and Lock Nut (4) (see Figure 4)
- Repeat the procedure on the other leg.
- Assemble the front bar. Insert the 2 spreaders into the joiner (clotheslines 2400mm long or less have a 1 piece spreader bar)
- Insert the end of the spreader into the arm.
- No screws are required to hold the spreader bar as the cord tension keeps everything in place.
- ****TIP:** you may need to use a rubber mallet or soft piece of wood to tap the spreader bar into the arms and ensure they are properly seated.
- Tighten all bolts. Do not over tighten as this will affect the smooth operation on the clothesline and may result in premature wear.




Figure 5 – Spreader Bar assembly




Figure 4 – Bolt Arm onto Leg and Stay

Feeding the cord:

- Unroll the cord.
TIP: Always keep hold of the loose ends as this will prevent tangles.
- Feed one end down the hole closest to the wall allowing approx. 300mm for tying.




Figure 7 – Tying off




Figure 8 – Tying off

- Tie off as shown in the Figs 7 and 8.
- Feed the cord through the remaining holes as shown in Fig 6.

- To tension the cord, hold the free end tightly. Starting at the line closest to the wall, pull down firmly on the middle of the cord. Repeat the process on the next cord, working your way outwards removing any slack. Repeat the process until there is sufficient tension in the cord.
- Tie the loose end as shown in Figs 5 and 6. Trim the ends of the cord, leaving 100mm to be fed through the hole as shown in Fig 6.
