



OPERATION AND ASSEMBLY
INSTRUCTIONS
V8/V10 PORTABLE CLOTHESLINE



Unpack all items
 Lay the top assembly on the ground and unfold the legs.







Remove screw from lower leg
 Insert Lower Leg into upper leg as shown in fig 2
 Insert screw and tighten. Use the coloured stickers to match up the legs

3. Stand frame up on legs Slide V arms into top rail





4. Unroll Cord

Pass cord through the holes as shown (fig 4)





Figure 5 – Tying off

Tie one end as shown in fig 5
Whilst keeping tension on the lose end, pull down on
the middle of each cord and remove any slack from the
line.

Tie off as shown below. If your line needs tensioning in the future, untie one knot and re-tighten.

OPERATION:

Lay the line on its side.

Press the button on the stay assembly and fold the legs in one at a time Lock the legs in place by rotating the latch
